Public Comments- None

Reports:

- A. Alliance for WI Youth – Ryan Dobbs spoke at the last AWY meeting Mary attended giving an update on Drug Trends. Mary handed out handouts regarding Operation Prevention- good information for schools
- B. Northwood Coalition- Mary reported about the “kNOw Meth” program and reports as distributed, the committee discussed using report at DEC meeting. AG Brad Schimmel is putting \$50,000 into campaign materials. Other counties are allowing people to walk into the Sheriff’s department and ask for help with meth/drugs without having to worry about arrests. 50 Deactivation kits came in and Stacy demonstrated how to use one. We are still waiting for 200 lockboxes and 50 lock bags to arrive. The committee discussed having \$500 to use on Dose of Reality campaign – for printing of the posters/ hand out at parent conferences and print an ad in the Resorter.
- C. AmeriCorps- Auttum reported she tracked 234 volunteers, a total of 1071 hour. As of right now she has tracked 106 volunteers this year.
- D. Health Department- Patti reported that they are having Wellness Coalition meetings in an effort to rebuild and would like this committee to be working on the AODA goals. Drug take back day will be April 28<sup>th</sup>.
- E. Law Enforcement- Drug Task Force has had no Meth calls/arrests in the last 3 months. Stacy talked about drugs being smuggled into prison in books recently
- F. Budget Report- Funding Request- the committee voted by email on the DHS planning grant for \$700. Mary discussed the BRKD request- Patti Moved to grant \$600, Brianna second- Approved

Unfinished Business

- A. Youth Group- Tri- County- Auttun shared the winner of the logo design.  
“Penguins4Prevention” team wants to do a campaign regarding not drinking around prom time, they will also be distributing flyers and posters for PWHLTM this year.
- B. Youth Summit- March 26-27, 4-5 kids and 1 chaperone can attend from our county- held in East Troy. Tri-County has possible candidates and Wautoma is checking to see if they have anyone.
- C. YRBS- will be done in March. Mary needs the names, emails/phone #'s of those administering or looking at results.
- D. Parents Who Host Loose The Most- Mary reported this will be the last year the state will have this campaign, and we have a lot of materials left to use.
