### Farm stand promotion and accessibility, including using EBT/Quest Card

UW-Extension created a website, <u>http://fyi.uwex.edu/wilocalfoodlocator/</u>, to list the locations of farm stands in the county. Committee members are asked to provide the locations of farm stands around the county.

Department of Aging has \$25 vouchers for participating farm stands in the county that are distributed at the senior meal sites on a first-come-first-served basis. They go fast.

# Farmers' Market at Waushara Community Church

The need for a credit card reader to use EBT/Quest Cards could be a reason to have a farmers' market. Looking at having a farmers market at Waushara Community Church. Church elders need the mission behind holding a farmers market and details. Look into doing this next year. This item should be reviewed in late fall by the committee. A couple of ideas to make the market possible are to have volunteers man the produce stands so farmers do not need to add the expense of paying to have their stand manned and have local food available for brunch using the stands produce.
